INTRODUCING THE
NEW THOMAS



The Nev Thomas is a purpose built pontoon style boat with wheelchair access and rail mounted fishing equipment designed to allow participants with a disability enjoy the experience of boat fishing.

Launching from Royal Perth Yacht Club at 10:00am we enjoy a morning of fishing on the Swan & Canning Rivers for up to three hours. All fishing equipment is provided and standard and motorised reels are available.

You are welcome to bring a picnic morning tea or lunch aboard (no alcohol please). There is an esky with ice on board for your use.

The Nev Thomas is available to anyone with a disability. There is a limit of eight passengers (participants and carers) including a maximum of four wheelchairs

Participants must be accompanied by someone to assist with their personal care, as volunteers are not able to provide personal care to participants.

Bookings are ESSENTIAL and should be made through the Association Coordinator. To ensure a fair opportunity for all; a maximum of 2 activities can be booked per calendar. Groups may book a maximum of four places per activity.

- Important to note:
- There are no toilet facilities on board
 - Participants must be able to arrive for a 10am start
 - No shore stops are made unless in the case of an emergency
 - Although the "Nev Thomas" navigates protected waters, the vessel can experience turbulent motion caused by wind or passing vessels. The outing is not recommended for anyone having a fear or apprehension of water or boat associated activities.
