SHORE FISHING

If you thought that fishing wasn't accessible to people with disabilities – then you haven't been to a 'Fishers with Disabilities' fishing activity.

Our programs are designed to increase independence for people with disabilities, and assist people with disabilities to engage in fishing as an outdoor recreational activity.

Our shore fishing activities achieve this by using universally accessible fishing spots and by the use of specially designed motorised rods and reels, which assist participants when necessary.

Trained volunteers provide full instruction on fishing and gear at the fishing activities, which are held at various ocean and river locations throughout the metropolitan area.

All disability types are catered for at activities and locations are chosen that have universal access to both fishing and toilet facilities. Participants must be accompanied by a carer at all times during the activity, as volunteers are not able to assist with personal care.

All fishing equipment and bait is provided and there is no charge for the activity.

To ensure a fair opportunity for all, a maximum of two activities can be booked per calendar period. Groups may book a maximum of four places per activity.
