



FISHERS WITH DISABILITIES PROGRAM

Fishers with Disabilities Association will be running fishing activities in Geraldton and anyone with a disability is welcome to come along and experience recreational fishing. All equipment and bait is provided and our activities are free or charge.

Volunteers will share knowledge and information and assist with hands on fishing skills and use of equipment. A standard manual reel may be suitable, or perhaps the use of one of our specially designed motorised reels will provide a more independent level of participation.

Volunteers are not able to assist with personal care and for this reason participants need to be accompanied by someone responsible for their supervision and safety. An adult must accompany all participants under the age of 18.

Two fishing activities will be held on **Tuesday 8th. May 2012** at the Batavia Coast Marina (near the museum).
