



## **FISHERS WITH DISABILITIES ASSOCIATION REGIONAL PROGRAM**

Participants in the Perth metropolitan area have regular opportunities to access Fishers with Disabilities activities; now the Fishers with Disabilities Association are once again bringing that opportunity to Southwest regional WA.

We will be holding fishing activities at various locations and anyone with a disability is welcome to come along and experience recreational fishing. All equipment and bait is provided and activities are free or charge.

Volunteers will share knowledge and information and assist with hands on fishing skills and use of equipment. A standard manual reel may be suitable, or perhaps the use of one of our specially designed motorised reels will provide a more independent level of participation.

Volunteers are not able to assist with personal care and for this reason participants need to be accompanied by someone responsible for their supervision and safety. An adult must accompany all participants under the age of 18.
